



## Book of good restaurants cooks up a storm on best-selling list

It may not be sales in the JK Rowling stratosphere, but local food surveyors Fergus Fung and Samantha Pong (pictured) are pretty pleased with the third edition of their Hong Kong restaurant guide, *WOM Guide* (Word of Mouth). The pocket-sized review, which came out late in November, has for the first time cracked the monthly top 10 best-seller lists of two prominent local bookshops. Bookazine announced this week that *WOM Guide* 2008 had hit No 8, while at Dymocks it shot all the way to No 3 - beaten in sales only by Booker prize-winner Anne Enright and an aerial photos coffee table tome



called *Over Hong Kong*.
